

Fishing Rules

At Torworth Grange we pride ourselves on the cleanliness of the lake, so please clean your swim before you leave and have respect for the lakes and fellow anglers. The owners accept no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury or theft whilst on the premises.

Please abide by the rules below:

- All landing nets, keep nets and unhooking mats are provided by Torworth Grange and must be used with no exceptions
 - All rod holders are to hold a fishing license
 - The correct tackle must be used
 - Barbless hooks only, on all lakes, except the carp lake where micro barbed hooks may be used
 - No braided mainline, braided hook lengths allowed
 - Minimum 10lb mainline on the carp lake
 - 2 rod limit on all the lakes
 - Carp care kit or similar must be used at all times
 - No fixed rig-leads must be able to break free with minimum amount of force
 - No shock leaders
 - All leaders maximum length 36 inch
 - Random rig checks, please do not be offended if you are asked!
 - No rods should be left unattended
 - No nuts of any kind
 - No live baiting
 - Floating baits are only permitted with constant vigilance to wildlife
 - Baitboats only allowed on the carp lake & to be used sensibly - keep within your zone!
 - All fish over 20lb must be reported to the bailiff
 - No retaining of fish, unless under match conditions
 - Keep all damaged or sick fish and report to manager or bailiff
 - No littering, swimming or wading
 - No drugs, alcohol in moderation
 - No BBQ's
 - Please put cigarette ends in pots provided
 - No refunds under any circumstances
 - Dogs are welcome, but please keep them on a lead at all times
